

GUIDELINES OF ABSTRACT SUBMISSION FOR POSTGRADUATES' SCIENTIFIC PRESENTATIONS

General guidelines:

- Preferred theme for presentation is fetal imaging and neuroimaging
- Please upload your abstract document on website through your login ID, typed and written in double space with liberal margins.
- Registration at the time of submission is mandatory.
- **Last date for abstract submission is 30th October 2024.**
- Only one paper presentation and one poster presentation will be permitted for each PG student.
- Your abstract is not successfully accepted until you receive a confirmation on the website.
- The presenting author is required to ensure that all co-author (s) are aware of the content of the abstract before submission.
- Abstract previously presented or published will not be accepted.
- The presenter will have to present in person at the conference to avail the certificate for paper and poster presentation
- All Scientific presentations competing for the medals should contain only the presenter's name on the first slide with no mention institution, place and name of co-authors or HOD anywhere in the presentation. You will be disqualified if this guideline is violated.
- Various aspects like quality, content, relevance, timing and way of presentation will be considered during assessment. The judge can disqualify a presentation if the presenter does not adhere to the rules and timing.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Guidelines for oral paper presentations:

- Abstract should not be more than 300 words.
- Abstract should be formatted in MS Word; Times Roman Font and Font Size 12 Pt.
- Abstract should be under the following headings – Title, Presenting Author, Aim, Methodology, Results and Conclusions.
- Papers should be based on original work of the presenters or from the member of the team.
- Total duration of the presentation will be 8 minutes comprising of 6 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for discussion.

Guidelines for posters presentations:

- Abstract should not be more than 250 words.
- Abstract should be formatted in MS Word; Times Roman Font and Font Size 12 Pt.
- Abstract should be under the following headings – Title, Introduction, Objectives, Method, Result, Conclusion, Key words
- Accepted size of poster is 3ft (W)x4ft (H).
- Illustrations/ images/ photographs use in the poster should be large enough to show relevant details clearly.
- A passport size photograph of the presenter should be included in the presentation.
